


Accommodation Options:

Directions to Darebin Arts and Entertainment Conference Centre:

The centre is located 8km north of the City and 20-45 minutes from Melbourne Airport (depending on the time of day) by car. Take the Tullamarine Freeway, exit left at Bell Street and travel 6 km to the corner of St Georges Road and Bell Street, Preston



Taxi:

Catch the Route 86 Tram - Docklands to Bundoora RMIT (Plenty Rd/McKimmies Rd). Stop 44 at the corner of Bell St and Plenty Rd, a further 7-10 minute walk to the Darebin Arts & Entertainment Centre.

Catch the Route 112 Tram - South Melbourne / St Kilda Beach - West Preston. Stop 40 at the corner of Bell St and Gilbert Rd, a further 10 minute walk to the Darebin Arts & Entertainment Centre.
