Australian Kodály Certificate Course 2016 Scholarships



General Information

The Australian Kodály Certificate is the only Australian fully accredited and nationally recognised program of teacher training in the Kodály approach. It was established some 20 years ago and during this time over 150 teachers have successfully completed the requirements. The certificate is normally completed over three years of part time study. In 2016, the Western Australian Branch will offer Level 1-3 of the 10-day course in the Primary or Secondary specialisations.

2016 WA Branch AKC Scholarship

KMEIA WA recognises that the AKC represents a significant financial undertaking for participants. With this in mind, Western Australian members of KMEIA who will undertake the full AKC course for assessment are eligible to apply for the 2016 WA Branch AKC Scholarship. A scholarship selection panel led by the President of KMEIA WA will award **up to four scholarships to the value of half of the super-early-bird course registration fee**.

The successful applicants will be required to write a report for the *Branch Newsletter* or other means as negotiated with the KMEIA WA Committee.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will:

- · be a current financial member of KMEIA and reside in the state of Western Australia;
- be enrolling in the AKC 2016 as a full-time participant for assessment;
- · demonstrate interest, experience and commitment to developing further their understanding of Kodály philosophy;
- outline how their teaching practice will benefit as a result of attending the AKC Course as a scholarship recipient.
