



Extension Studies – Choir (10 hours)

Overview: Extension studies: Choir allows participants the opportunity to broaden their experience in choral music, striving for excellence in a final performance.

Dates: Block 1 (8 days): Saturday 2 July to Sunday 10 July 2016 (Wednesday 6 July off)
Block 2 (2 days): Saturday 1 October to Sunday 2 October 2016

Time: 2.00pm – 3.00pm

Venue: Presbyterian Ladies' College (room to be announced)

Concert: Sunday 10 July 2016, 3.30pm.

Time Commitment: In addition to the daily classes (total 10 hours), students will need to put aside time to for memorisation of repertoire. Students are expected to perform at the final concert as part of the AKC Course Choir on Sunday 10 July 2016.

Materials: Students will need to a pencil and black display folder. Access to a piano or piano keyboard is strongly recommended.

Set Text: Csernyik, R. (Editor). Let Us Sing. *Sound Thinking Australia*.

Course Content:

Each session will contain warm up activities and vocal technique. Participants will learn appropriate warm up exercises and exercises to develop voice production through breathing, articulation and vowel placement.

Assessment:

- Assessment will be based on punctual class attendance and the student's willingness and preparedness to participate in all rehearsals and performances.
- Assessment will be graded as a Pass/Fail
