- Each scholarship and award has its own information sheet and application / nomination form.
- Information sheets for each scholarship / award (including background, value, eligibility and applicant submission procedures) are the central point of information for each scholarship / award.



- Applications / nominations are reviewed by the Scholarships and Awards Committee and recipients are recommended to National Council based only on the evidence submitted as part of the application / nomination
- KMEIA reserves the right to not award a scholarship / award recipient if there are no suitable applicants / nominees.

The following procedures relate to the Australian Kodály Scholarship (AKS):

- Late December odd year: Information sheet and application form made available on the national website.
- 1 January even year: Official date for applications being accepted
- 31 March even year: Closing date for applications
- Early April even year: National Administrator compiles submissions and forwards to the Scholarships and Awards Committee Convenor
- Late April even year: Scholarships and Awards Committee under its Convenor review applications and recommend a successful recipient to the National Council based only on the evidence provided in the application and references
- Beginning of May (before Super Early Bird Registration) even year: Successful recipient informed by the Convenor, then announced to members and the public through online communication including the successful recipient name, state of residence and their project details. The recipient is asked if they will travel to the National Conference. No financial assistance is offered to attend the conference. A presentation at the national conference still occurs even if the recipient is unable to attend and a local presentation may be made by a representative of the National Council to the recipient at a later date
- Late September/October even year: A presentation is made at the biennial National Conference by the National President
- October even year: Funds transferred to recipient(s) by electronic bank transfer
- 18 months after announcement of award: Final date for submission of recipient report. Final report uploaded to the national website

The following procedures relate to the Enid Scott Conference Award (ESCA):

- Late December odd year: Information sheets and nomination form made available on the national website.
- 1 January even year: Official date for nominations being accepted
- 31 March even year: Closing date for nominations
- Early April even year: National Administrator compiles submissions and forwards to the Scholarships and Awards Committee
- Late April even year: Scholarships and Awards Committee under its Convenor review
