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1. The college is accessed via the Wyangan Gate entrance (34 on map).
2. Take your first right when entering, down “Bryce Lindores Way”. From here, limited parking is available at the Pool Carpark (21b) and further at the Pool Car park (26).

The Open Classroom will be conducted in the Junior School Music Room (The Rowe Building – 18 on map).

There will be signage around to help you find my room. Directions from the Ray Carpark are:

- Look for the Somerset Spartans Gym and Basketball courts. Cross these and make your way up the stairs.
- Keep heading in the same direction and cross the courtyard, past the Knowledge and Information Precinct and student toilets
- Head down the stairs to the Rowe building, and look for the xylophones!
